LOS ANGELES (AP)-FOUR EX-CUBAN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ANNOUNCED PLANS FRIDAY TO SEEK WORLDWIDE UNIFICATION OF EXILED CUBANS.

THE FOUR CONFERRED IN LOS ANGELES THIS WEEK AT THE INVITATION OF THE CUBAN CIVIC COMMITTEE OF CALIFORNIA, AND DREW UP A COMMUNIQUE ENTITLED, "THE LOS ANGELES DECLARATION."

THE FOUR--DR. CARLOS PRIO SOCARRAS, LAST CONSTITUTIONAL PRESIDENT OF CUBA; DR. EMILIO NUNEZ PORTUONDO, FORMER CUBAN ENVOY TO THE UNITED NATIONS; DR. EDUARDO SUAREZ RIVAS, FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE CUBAN SENATE, AND DR. RAFAEL GUAS INCLAN, FORMER CUBAN VICE-PRESIDENT--CONFERRED IN LOS ANGELES THIS WEEK AT THE INVITATION OF THE CUBAN CIVIC COMMITTEE OF CALIFORNIA. PORTUONDO FLEW HERE FROM PANAMA. THE OTHERS CAME FROM MIAMI, FLA.

IN THE COMMUNIQUE, THE EXILED LEADERS SAID THEY WOULD WORK FOR UNITY AMONG THE 600,000 CUBAN EXILES, AND RECOMMENDED AN ATTEMPT TO SELECT LEADERS TO SPEAK FOR THE ENTIRE EXILE BODY.
