

Immigration Office Orders Ouster of Cuban Exile Aide

MIAMI, May 15 (UPI)—United States Immigration officials ruled Monday that a Cuban exile leader, Felipe Rivero, should be "excluded" from this country.

If the order is upheld on review, he would be the first known exile leader to be ousted from the United States. Authorities emphasized, however, that he would not be sent back to Cuba.

The ruling against the 43-year-old survivor of the Bay of Pigs invasion must be upheld by a regional immigration office at Richmond, Va., before it can be enforced. The review was expected to take about 10 days.
