RIVERO 350

MIAMI, FLA. (AP)-PIERY FELIPE RIVERO, WHO IN A FUTILE EFFORT TO BE FREED ON BOND TESTIFIED HOW HE RAN A BOATLOAD OF ARMS FROM FLORIDA TO CUBA, FACES A DEPORTATION HEARING TODAY.

THE SURPRISE CONFESSION CAME WEDNESDAY IN FEDERAL COURT AS RIVERO TRIED TO GET OUT OF THE JAIL WHERE HE HAD BEEN HELD FOR 20 DAYS. THE CONFESSION LEFT HIM WIDE OPEN FOR GUN RUNNING CHARGES.

THE MUNITIONS RUNNING WOULD MAKE RIVERO AN ILLEGAL ALIEN, SUBJECT TO DEPORTATION, BUT WOULD ALSO MAKE HIM ELIGIBLE FOR RELEASE ON BOND. RIVERO HAS BEEN HELD UNDER THE EXCLUSION ACT, UNDER WHICH U.S. IMMIGRATION SERVICE OFFICIALS CAN REFUSE BOND.

JUDGE WILLIAM O. JEHRTENS, IN DENYING RIVERO'S BID, SAID THE ANTI-CASTRO LEADER HAD NOT EXHAUSTED HIS ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES BEFORE THE U.S. IMMIGRATION SERVICE.

IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS WANT THE 43-YEAR-OLD BAY OF PIGS INVASION VETERAN DEPORTED ON GROUNDS HE IS AN ADVOCATE OF VIOLENCE AGAINST COMMUNIST CUBA.

THE DEPORTATION HEARING WAS RESCHEDULED FOR 1 P.M. TODAY. IT HAD BEEN POSTPONED PENDING THE OUTCOME OF WEDNESDAY'S FEDERAL COURT DECISION.

BECAUSE RIVERO DID NOT SEEK A CHANGE IN HIS STATUS BEFORE THE IMMIGRATION SERVICE, JUDGE MEHRTENS SENT THE CASE BACK WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

TWO OTHER CUBANS SUPPORTED RIVERO'S STORY OF THE TRIP TO CUBA AND HIS ATTORNEY, GINO NEGRETTI, TRIED TO LINK THE U.S. CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY TO THE SHIPMENT.

ORLANDO ATIENZA AND FERNANDO GONZALEZ TESTIFIED THAT THEY LEFT MIAMI WITH RIVERO OCT. 10 FROM A "SECRET CANAL" AND DELIVERED MACHINE GUNS, RIFLES AND AMMUNITION TO THE CUBAN TOWN OF NUEVA VISTA. THEY SAID THEY SNAKED BACK INTO MIAMI OCT. 15 WITHOUT REPORTING TO CUSTOMS.

"ISN'T IT TRUE THAT ON THIS AND SIMILAR TRIPS YOU WERE PROVIDED MATERIALS BY THE CIA?" NEGRETTI ASKED GONZALEZ.

THE COURT UPHELD GOVERNMENT OBJECTIONS AND THE QUESTION WENT UNANSWERED.

RIVERO IS A MEMBER OF THE CUBAN NATIONALIST ASSOCIATION, WHICH HAS CLAIMED CREDIT FOR RAIDS ON CUBA AND SEERAL TERRORIST BOMBINGS IN THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA.
