

**Avowed Castro Foe Pleads
Guilty in Bogus Bill Case**

A man who said he was trying to raise money to overthrow Premier Fidel Castro of Cuba pleaded guilty yesterday in Federal Court here to counterfeiting charges.

The defendant was Sergio Castro, 46 years old and no relation to the Premier. He had lived at 23 West 73d Street and was indicted Aug. 7 with five other Cubans and a Puerto Rican. Authorities said they had \$1-million in counterfeit \$20, \$50 and \$100 bills.

Castro is in custody in Hudson County Jail, Jersey City, facing 20 years in prison if convicted of armed bank robbery charges. He can get a maximum of 70 years and a \$35,000 fine on the Federal charges. He will be sentenced Sept. 26.
