Avowed Castro Foe Pleads Guilty in Bogus Bill Case

A man who said he was try-ing to raise money to over-throw Premier Fidel Cstro of Cuba pleaded guilty yesterday in Federal Court here to count-

erfeiting charges.

The defendant was Sergio Castro, 46 years old and no re-lation to the Premier. He had lived at 23 West 73d Street and

lived at 23 West 73d Street and was indicted Aug. 7 with five other Cubans and a Puerto Rican. Authorities aid they had \$1-million in counterfeit \$20, \$50 and \$100 bills.

Castro is in custody in Hudson County Jail, Jersey City, facing 20 years in prison if convicted of armed bank robbery charges. He can get a maximum of 70 years and a \$35,000 fine on the Federal charges. He will be sentenced Sept. 26.
