MIAMI (AP)-A 21-YEAR-OLD MARINE DESERTER ACCUSED OF MURDERING A FELLOW SOLDIER-OF-FORTUNE AT A SECRET HAITIAN GUERRILLA CAMP DEEP IN THE EVERGLADES SURRENDERED TO SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES FRIDAY.

CHARLES SMITH, 21, A HAITIAN, GAVE HIMSELF UP AS A POSSE OF CARBINE-CARRYING DEPUTIES ARRIVED AT THE CAMP 50 MILES WEST OF MIAMI TO SEARCH FOR HIM.

MONROE COUNTY SHERIFF ROBERT BROWN HAD ISSUED A WANTED-FOR-MURDER BULLETIN FOR SMITH THURSDAY, ACCUSING HIM OF KILLING GERALD D. BAKER DURING A LIVE AMMUNITION MANEUVER TUESDAY.

BAKER DIED EN ROUTE TO A MIAMI HOSPITAL, AND DEPUTIES WAME TO THE CAMP TO INVESTIGATE. THEY ARRESTED 12 MEN, A CANADIAN, AN AMERICAN AND 10 HAITIANS. THE 12 WERE CHARGED THURSDAY AS ACCESSORIES TO MURDER.
