The first "freedom flight" from Cuba after a Fidel Castro-ordered three-week break in the program landed here yesterday with 94 Cuban refugees aboard.

Castro announced August 31 that the flights, which have brought 245,795 refugees to the United States would end shortly. This is the last week of scheduled flights, but State Department officials said there might be sporadic flights until the end of the year.
