

2 Reported Dead in a Raid on Cuba

Havana Radio reported yesterday that two persons were killed and four others injured in a speedboat strafing raid carried out by commando "mercenaries" against a Cuban fishing village.

In a broadcast monitored here, Havana Radio said the speedboat raid was launched from a "mother" ship Tuesday night against the village of Boca de Sama in Oriente province on the Northeast coast of Cuba.

A border patrol guard and an interior ministry policeman were killed in the raid, Havana Radio said, and a 15-year-old girl, one of the four persons injured, lost her leg as a result of gunshot wounds.

In New York, the exiled Cuban Liberation Force said the action by its force marked "the first military operation in the war to free Cuba from its Communist yoke."
