**Cubans' Ouster Delayed.  
Pending Appeal of Order**

BELLE CHASSE, La., Nov. 3 (UPI)—Immigration officials today held up the deportation of 22 Cubans pending appeal of the expulsion.

The Cubans, 19 of whom claimed to be sugar cane technologists who wanted to attend a convention in nearby New Orleans, were ordered deported yesterday by Herman Immigration and Naturalization Service. They immediately filed an appeal to the five-man Immigration Appeals Board in Washington.

Immigration officials said today that there were no plans to move the Cubans from the naval air station at Belle Chasse pending the appeal. The Cubans were being held in a bachelor officers building at the military station during the deportation and appeal proceedings.
