Terrorist Unit Says It Killed Exile

MIAMI, Nov. 4 (UPI)—A Cuban terrorist group calling itself "the secret organization Zero" claimed responsibility today for killing Rolando (El Tigre) Masferrer, who died last Friday when a bomb exploded in his car.

In an unsigned communique sent to local news media, the group claimed it murdered Masferrer because of his "systematic work in the destruction of the anti-Communist struggle" and his

relation to Cuba's internal intelligence unit.

"His assassination, like that of Jose Elias de la Torre, should serve as an example for those who disdain the cause of Cuban liberation. It is necessary to cleanse the exile community in order to liberate Cuba," the Zero statement said.

Toriente was shot to death in April, 1974, in the living room of his Coral Gables home.
