Edwin A. Walker, the retired major general and conservative activist, was fined \$25 for having violated a curfew in Dallas while keeping

few in Dallas while keeping a prayer vigil for the wounded Governor of Alabama, George C. Wallace. A policeman testified that General Walker had refused to leave a park at midnight, May 16, in violation of a law designed to curb narcotics traffic in parks. But Municipal Judge Gordon MacDowell seemed to think the general deserved more justice, and advised him to appeal the case in hope of "a more authoritative opinion."
