

John Birch Group Fights China Visit

Belmont, Mass.

American Opinion, a publishing arm of the John Birch Society, is circulating petitions urging President Nixon to cancel his visit to China arranged by an "un-American evil genius named Kissinger."

The petitions, in the form of letters to the President with space for the names and addresses of five signers on each, say the trip would be "morally wrong" and would "completely repudiate both the principles and the promises" on which Nixon was elected.

Characterizing the Communist Chinese leaders as "brazen mass murderers," the petition says that Nixon's present steps appear to be guided by your un-American evil genius named Kissinger."

Henry A. Kissinger, the German-born former Harvard government professor who is a special adviser to the President, arranged Nixon's forthcoming China visit during a secret meeting in Peking with Chinese Premier Chou En-lai.
