PARIS, JUNE 15 (AP)-MRS. NGO DINH NHU CHARGED TODAY THAT "CHILD-ISH TRICKS" BY U.S. OFFICIALS ARE DELAYING A VISA FOR HER TO GO TO THE UNITED STATES FOR A SPEAKING ENGAGEMENT.

IN A LETTER TO U.S. MAMBASSADOR CHARLES E. BOHLEN, WITH COPIES TO THE PRESS, SOUTH VIET NAM'S FORMER FIRST LADY CLAIMED NO ONE INFORMED HER THAT SHE HAD TO FILL OUT AN APPLICATION FORM. SHE SAID SHE HAD NEVER HEARD OF APPLICATION FORMS AND SAID THEY WERE NEVER REQUIRED OF HER BEFORE. SHE REPEATED HER COMPLAINT IN A LETTER ADDRESSED TO SECRETARY OF STATE DEAN RUSK.

AN EMBASSY SPOKESMAN HAD NO IMMEDIATE COMMENT, BUT SAID THE MATTER WAS BEING INVESTIGATED. THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY CLUB OF FLUSHING, L.I., N.Y. ANNOUNCED A WEEK AGO THAT MRS. NHU, SISTER-IN-LAW OF THE LATE PRESIDENT NGO DINH DIEM OF SOUTH VIET NAM, HAD BEEN INVITED TO SPEAK JULY 7 ON "THE TRUTH OF THE VIET NAM AFFAIR." SHE HAS CALLED THE UNITED STATES AN "ENEMY CAMOUFLAGED AS ALLIES AND FRIENDS."
