## Saigon Reportedly Warned Of Bullet-Shooting Cameras

SAIGON, South Vietnam, Sept. 22 (UPI)—The United States Embassy has warned the Saigon Government's military intelligence branch to watch for Communist terrorists who may be using Japanese-made cameras converted to guns with silencers, South Vietnamese sources said today.

"The 'cameras' are Japanese-made Yashicas adapted to be guns," the sources said. "They are capable of shooting five rounds of 5-mm. dumdum bullets."

A United States Embassy spokesman denied any knowledge of the report.
