CORPUS CHRISTI, TEX. JAN. 16 (AP)-EVERETT LOUIS DEHARPPORTE (CAP D,H) REMAINED IN JAIL TODAY IN LIEU OF A \$50,000 BOND ON A CHARGE OF SENDING A THREATENING LETTER TO PRESIDENT LYNDON JOHNSON.

DEHARPPORTE, 58, WAS ARRESTED AT A MOTEL HERE YESTERDAY ON A WARRANT FROM THE SECRET SERVICE AT ST. PAUL, MINN. HE IS A TRAVELING SALESMAN FROM MINNEAPOLIS.

STATE REP. TONY BONILLA, APPEARING AS DEFENSE COUNSEL, ASKED A FULL HEARING ON THE CHARGE. U.S. COMMISSIONER JAMES C. MARTIN GRANTED IT BUT SET NO DATE IMMEDIATELY.

IN MINNEAPOLIS, U.S. ATTY. MILES LORD WOULD NOT DIVULGE CONTENTS OF THE LETTER AND SAID:

"BECAUSE OF THE UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CASE, WE WERE PROMPTED TO FILE THE COMPLAINT HERE. BUT IT IS A CASE THAT ORDINARILY WOULD BE PROSECUTED IN TEXAS, AND I EXPECT ANY FURTHER COMMENT ON THIS WILL HAVE TO COME FROM THERE."
