DALLAS, TEX., DEC 8 (AP)-A U.S. DISTRICT COURT TODAY ORDERED A PSYCHIATRIC EXAMINATION FOR EDWARD SAMEL, 44, WHO IS CHARGED WITH ORALLY THREATENING THE LIFE OF PRESIDENT JOHNSON.

SAMEL, ARRESTED MONDAY, IS ACCUSED OF MAKING THE THREATS AT A SAVINGS AND LOAN OFFICE IN TAMPA, FLA., LAST MARCH.

HE WILL BE TAKEN TO THE FEDERAL MEDICAL CENTER IN SPRINGFIELD, MO. COURT ATTACHES SAID. THE HOSPITAL WILL SUBMIT A REPORT TO FEDERAL COURT AND SAMEL WILL BE RETURNED TO THE DALLAS COUNTY JAIL AT THE END OF THE OBSERVATION PERIOD.

THE MOTION FOR THE SANITY INVESTIGATION SAID THAT WHEN ARRESTED SAMEL TOLD A SECRET SERVICE MAN; "I KNOW YOU. PRESIDENT JOHNSON HAS SENT YOU TO KILL ME."

OFFICERS SAID HE HAD THREE RIFLES, TWO SHUTGONS, A PISTOL AND AMMUNITION WHEN ARRESTED.
