KLAMATH FALLS, ORE., APRIL 4 (AP)-A 51-YEAR-OLD TRANSIENT IS HELD IN THE KLAMATH COUNTY JAIL ON A FEDERAL CHARGE OF THREATENING THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

THE SECRET SERVICE FILED A COMPLAINT TODAY IN PORTLAND WITH U.S. COMMISSIONER CLAIRE MUNDORFF, AGAINST RICHARD MOORE.

MOORE WAS ARRESTED LAST WEDNESDAY BY POLICE AFTER "ASSASSINATE JOHNSON" AND "YOU SHOULD BE ASHAMED TO BE AN AMERICAN, ASSASSINATE JOHNSON AND MCNAMARA TO SAVE THE WORLD" WAS WRITTE ON THE WALLS OF THE KLAMATH COUNTY MUSEUM AND LIBRARY AND THE CITY BUS DEPOT.

AN AMERICAN FLAG WAS ALSO SLASHED AT THE MUSEUM.

THE COMMISSIONER SET BAIL AT \$5,000. FEDERAL LAW SETS A MAXIMUM OF FIVE YEARS IN PRISON AND \$1,000 FINE FOR THREATENING THE PRESIDENT.
