

**Book Depository Is Sought  
As a Kennedy Memorial**

DALLAS, June 1 (AP)—A plan to buy the Texas School Book Depository Building and create a museum of contemporary history dedicated to President Kennedy was reported today by the newly formed American Memorial Institute.

The shots that killed President Kennedy came from the building, investigators say.

The institute, a nonprofit corporation, was formed by Al Turnisky, a Dallas manufacturers' representative, and Pat Malloy, a lawyer.

"We plan to start our drive by trying to secure funds from charitable foundations," Mr. Turnisky said. "Then, after the Citizens Memorial Committee and the National Library in Boston have finished their public drives, we'll accept contributions from the public."
