
Student Appears to Win Chat With Mrs. Mitchell

WASHINGTON, March 10 (UPI)—Mrs. John N. Mitchell, wife of the Attorney General, apparently intends to grant her first interview in months to a bearded college student who gave \$100 for it at an auction.

The student, Jan Bridge, 19 years old, is tentatively scheduled to see Mrs. Mitchell April 10.

There was a misunderstanding over exactly what Mr. Bridge was buying at the George Washington University Scholarship Auction. He thought it was an interview, and Mrs. Mitchell said it was lunch.

In her last public interview, in December, Mrs. Mitchell received widespread publicity for her criticism of antiwar demonstrators. Since then, the Justice Department has recorded more than 40 requests from newspapers, magazines and television for a chance to see Mrs. Mitchell.
