Agnew to Head U.S. Delegation To South Korea

Washington

Vice President Spiro Agnew was named by President Nixon yesterday to head a U.S. delegation at the inauguration of South Korean President Chung Hee Park on July 1 and to go on for a visit to eight countries in Asia, Europe, the Middle East and Africa.

The White House said the June 26 - July 28 trip of the vice president will be to "demonstrate the President's continuing, personal interest in the countries involved and to develop first-hand knowledge of their problems and progress."

The almost month-long trip is the third in which Agnew has been assigned to represent President Nixon in meetings with world leaders.
