A Deal to Oust Thieu Reported

Paris - (UPI) - A French newspaper said today the United States in secret negotiations has accepted two key peace demands of the Vietnamese Communists, including replacement of South Vietnamese President Nguyen Van Thieu.

In a dispatch from Washington, the newspaper France—Soir said the U.S. concessions were offered by presidential adviser Henry Kissinger in a secret meeting in Paris early this week with Hanoi's Le Duc Tho.
