Packard's View Of Why Hanoi Invited Clark

Former Attorney General Ramsey Clark was invited to North Vietnam "because they knew he would be a sucker for their propaganda line," a major supporter of President Nixon's re-election said here yesterday.

David Packard, former undersecretary of defense and now chairman of the Bay Area Citizens' Committee for the Re-election of the President, said:

"It is unfortunate that Americans like Ramsey Clark and Jane Fonda allow themselves to be used as tools for the Communists because this simply makes it much more difficult to bring about an end to the war in Indochina which will be in the interest of all of the people of Indochina, not just the Communists."
