

A.C.L.U. Assails Attempt To Enjoin Anti-Nixon Group

The American Civil Liberties Union described as "utterly unconstitutional" yesterday the Federal Government's attempt to enjoin the National Committee for the Impeachment of President Nixon from spending money for any political purpose.

"This attempt at prior restraint is the most incredible violation of the First Amendment yet to come to our attention," the A.C.L.U. and its New York branch said in a

statement, the Associated Press reported.

The Justice Department filed a suit in United States District Court here Thursday, seeking an injunction against the committee until it agrees to comply with regulations issued under the Federal Election Act of 1971.
