Candidate Scores Kissinger

CHARLOTTE, N. C., Oct. 3 (UPI)—Representative John G. Schmitz, Republican of California, warned today of a totalitarian government if President Nixon was re-elected and called Henry A. Kissinger, Presidential adviser on national security affairs, "the unelected, de facto President." He charged that Mr. Kissinger "is the true President of the United States right now" and said the Presidential adviser "is from the Council of Foreign Relations, which is dedicated to a one-world socialist system."
