Report on Professors For Nixon

WASHINGTON — (AP) — President Nixon's 1972 support from college professors was the greatest given any Republican in 20 years, but the prevailing attitude of professors toward both candidates was negative, a study reported yesterday.

The study, by professors Seymour Lipset of Harvard and Everett Ladd of the University of Connecticut, was published by the American Enterprise Institute for Public Policy Research.

The study said Nixon received 43 percent of the faculty vote. That compared with 39 percent in 1968 and was the highest since the 44 percent for Dwight Eisenhower in 1952. The survey was based on pre-election and post-election interviews with 472 professors.
