**SAXBE'S NET WORTH
IS PUT AT \$275,000**

COLUMBUS, Ohio, Nov. 3 (AP)—Senator William B. Saxbe, Republican of Ohio, nominated to be United States Attorney General, said Saturday his net worth is \$275,000, including 25,000 shares in a ski resort in Ohio's Logan County. In a telephone interview from Washington, Senator Saxbe said the stock is in Ohio Resorts, Incorporated, which owns the Valley High Ski Resort, near Bellefontaine.

He said he also had a 238-acre cattle farm in Champaign County near his 12-acre residence at Mechanicsburg. Among other property he listed a cabin at the ski resort, a cabin and acreage in northern Michigan and a house in Costa Rica, which he described as "just a vacation place." He said the ski stock is selling at \$2.75 per share compared to a peak of \$10 a share. "We had a couple of bad winters up there," he added. Mr. Saxbe got into the ski-resort business in 1967, a year before he was elected to the Senate.

Senator Saxbe said that if his confirmation as Attorney General did not work out, he would return to his Mechanicsburg home, "where I was headed in the first place." Last month he had said he would not seek re-election to the Senate.
