Nixon's Florida Compound Is Sold

Key Biscayne, Fla.

One of the four houses in Richard Nixon's vacation compound here has been sold for \$200,000 to Melvin Jacobs, chairman of the board of Burdines Department Stores.

The home, sold by real estate salesman Jerry Clarke for Edward Campbell Jr., was originally put on the market a year ago for \$400,000.

Another house in the compound, owned by Robert Abplanalp, a friend of Mr. Nixon's also is for sale for \$385,000.

The houses owned by Mr. Nixon and by banker Bebe Rebozo, another close Nixon friend, apparently are not on the market.
