

Probe Urged of Anti-Nixon Violence

Sacramento

A Democratic state Senator asked special Watergate prosecutor Archibald Cox yesterday to investigate the demonstration and violence that accompanied President Nixon's 1970 visit to San Jose.

Senator Alfred E. Alquist, in a statement to reporters, said he made a similar request to the U.S. Senate Watergate committee earlier, but was told its investigation was limited to the 1972 elections.

In a letter, Alquist said the inconclusive results of a grand jury probe into the rock-throwing demonstration that met Nixon's motorcade "would appear to leave only the security directives [sic] themselves as an explanation of how this dangerous situation was allowed to develop."
