Mrs. Nixon 'Is Excited'
About Her Trip to China

WASHINGTON, Nov. 30 (AP)—Mrs. Richard M. Nixon says she's happy about accompanying the President on his week-long visit to mainland China in February.

The White House announced today that Mrs. Nixon would be going and she said shortly afterward, "I'm very excited and looking forward to it very much."

Since President has planned a strictly working visit, there had been no speculation about whether Mrs. Nixon would be included.

But Henry A. Kissinger, presidential adviser on national security affairs, said that "at the invitation of the Government of the People's Republic of China, Mrs. Nixon will accompany the President on his trip to China."

The Communist country is one of the few that Mrs. Nixon has never visited.
