GRASS VALLEY, Calif.,
April 1 (UPI) — Mrs. Anna V.
Milhous, whose husband is
is a first cousin of President
Nixon, has established a 40member welfare rights organization to fight "abuses of
poor people."

Mrs. Milhous, 48 years old,
who is crippled by arthritis,
and her husband, Phillip, 56,
who suffers a heart ailment,
received national attention
last year when she spoke out
against proposed cutbacks in
federally financed legal aid
to the poor.

Mr. Milhous received \$182
a month in Social Security
disability benefits. His wife
received \$115 a month in Social Security, plus welfare,
she said.

Mrs. Milhous said in a telephone interview that the new
"low-income welfare rights
organization of Nevada County" that she was founding
was aimed at "negotiating"
improvements with the county welfare department.
