Protester Gets a Job

The singer who displayed an antiwar poster to a White House audience in January — and later said job offers had plummeted — now has an engagement to perform, a Hollywood public relations man said yesterday.

A spokesman for entertainer Connie Stevens said Miss Stevens has hired Carole Feraci to rejoin her act for season - opening performances May 26-27-28 at Magic Mountain, a big amusement park at Valencia, Calif.

"Connie has no political ax to grind," said the spokesman, Frank Liberman. "Carole has worked very well in her act for several years, particularly in Las Vegas. Connie is hiring her for this engagement along with other singers and dancers with whom she has worked before.

"She likes Carole and is glad that she is available."

After the White House incident last January 28, Miss Feraci said she had accepted the job with the Ray Coniff singers with the intention of making a peace demonstration in front of President Nixon.
