According to a story in the San Francisco Progress, by 1975 any police officer or government agency will have instant access to your child's life history, school grades or relations with teachers or classroom associates, if the child has been identified as a potential criminal.

Children in kindergarten and the primary grades who are so identified will have their names and fingerprints placed in a central computerized file operated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Children identified as pre-criminal will not only have a computerized record for the rest of their lives, they will also receive attention and extensive treatment in behavior modification during the years they are in school. Parents will not be informed of the computer file, nor will they be told that their children's behavior is being modified. "
