## Bebe's Bargain For Julie, David

Julie Nixon Eisenhower started moving furnishings into a \$100,000 Bethesda, Md., home yesterday, which she and her husband have rented at "a special rate" from the President's close friend, C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo. The White House said she and her husband, David, won't be moving in until about April 1, after Lieutenant (j.g.) Eisenhower gets out of the Navy. The white brick, two-bedroom home is located near the Burning Tree Golf Club in Bethesda, Md., where former President Eisenhower used to play golf.

Helen Smith said Rebozo purchased the house "as an investment in this area because he comes up here so often" from his Florida home on visits with President Nixon.

The rent for the home, which includes a swimming pool, was not disclosed, but Mrs. Smith said it would be at a "special rate," less than Rebozo could get on the open market, "because they're old friends."

Mrs. Eisenhower wants to plant a vegetable garden and raise tomatoes, Mrs. Smith said, and "her mother, who loves to garden, is going to help her plant the garden."
