Nixon Popularity Drops

The American public's approval of President Nixon's performance in office continues to plummet and now stands at his low point to date - 45 per cent.

This nationwide Gallup survey was conducted shortly after the President's televised April 30 speech dealing with Watergate. Generally, an overt action such as this, by a Bresident, serves to boost his popularity rating. But in this case it fails to check a $3\frac{1}{2}$ -month decline in Mr. Nixon's popularity.

... The percentage of those disapproving is up 17 per cent since late January to the present level of 42 per cent - the highest disapproval rate ever recorded for Mr. Nixon.
