From testimony before Ervin committee (morning session), of Lt. Gen. Vernon A. Walters:

Sen. Herman E. Talmadge: General Walters, for how long and in what capacity have you known President Nixon?

Walters: I have known President Nixon, I believe,
Senator, since 1957. As I testified earlier, I served as
his interpreter during a trip he made through eight
countries in South America. Subsequently I saw him only
on the anniversary of the stoning in Caracas where the car
was attacked by a mob. He used to give a party during the
time he was [one or two words garbled] in the years he was
Vice President. He used to give a party once a year.
I went to that. In the years between Mr. Nixon's
departure from the White House and his re-election as
President I saw him perhaps three times in those eight or
nine - or whatever it was - years. After Mr. Nixon became
President I accompanied him on two trips around Europe ....
