

Again This Year-- Pat's the One

Pat Nixon has been named Good Housekeeping magazine's "most admired woman" for the second year in a row, it was announced yesterday.

Julie Nixon Eisenhower, finished tenth in the poll for her "spirited defense" of her father, President Nixon.

The magazine said Mrs. Nixon won twice as many first place votes as Mamie Eisenhower, the runner-up.

Helen McCain Smith, Mrs. Nixon's press secretary, said First Lady was "very thrilled" when she learned of the poll, which will be published in the January issue. She quoted Mrs. Nixon as saying that it was "indeed among my most cherished Christmas gifts."

About 1500 of the magazine's subscribers were selected at random to participate in the poll.

Rose Kennedy placed third, followed by Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meier, Lady Bird Johnson, Shirley Temple Black, actress Patricia Neal, Princess Grace, and Dr. Joyce Brothers.
