

Editor — I am tired of hearing, as Ernest Van den Haag tells us December 24 that "Mr. Nixon got us out of Vietnam . . ." The United States currently supplies the Saigon government with 90 per cent of its operating budget and \$900 million in military equipment. In 1973 we contributed \$20 million to President Thieu's police system, which keeps more than 200,000 political dissenters in prison. We provide the planes, the jet fuel, the bombs, the pilot training, and the mechanics, to the Saigon air force, which has been bombing Vietnamese villages since the ceasefire. There is still a war in Vietnam and the U.S. is a long way from being out of it.
