Pat Nixon suffered a feeling of shame just after her husband resigned the presidency, but she now feels secure that he made a great contribution to the nation, a family friend said yesterday.

Rabbi Baruck Korff said the White House he said. in an interview that Mrs. Nixon. who will be 63 March 16, has stayed up many sleepless nights with her husband and grown closer to him. She has "suffered a lot and aged" since last August 9 when they moved out of.
