Disbarred in 1952, after his perjury conviction in the "pumpkin" papers" spy case, he was ordered readmitted Tuesday by the state's Supreme Court, which had never before reversed a disbarment. Justice Francis J. Quirico, who administered the oath, did not single out Mr. Hiss. Later, Mr. Hiss said that he was "very gratified" and confirmed that he would seek readmission to the New York bar.
