

Pat Nixon Is Being Treated For Bronchitis in Hospital

Pat Nixon was undergoing treatment yesterday for acute viral bronchitis at the same hospital where she recovered from a stroke nearly two years ago.

A statement from Long Beach Memorial Hospital said the 66-year-old former first lady is progressing satisfactorily in her treatment for

the lung infection. She is expected to remain at the hospital several more days.

Mrs. Nixon entered the facility Monday afternoon accompanied by Secret Service agents after making the 60-mile drive from the Nixon's home in San Clemente. Her husband visited her briefly during the night.

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
