RK, SEPT. 21 (AP)-LETTERS WRITTEN BY THE LATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AND HIS WIFE, JACQUELINE, WILL BE SOLD AT THE SAME AUCTION WITH WRITINGS OF THE LATE PRESIDENT'S ASSASSIN, LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

THE SALE SEPT. 30 BY AUTOGRAPH DEALER CHARLES HAMILTON WILL INCLUDE TWO HANDWRITTEN LETTERS FROM THE PRESIDENT. ONE WAS TO A 93-YEAR OLD WOMAN WHO HAD WRITTEN THAT SHE, A LIFELONG REPUBLICAN, HAD VOTED FOR HIM. ANOTHER TURNED DOWN A YOUNG ACTOR'S REQUEST FOR AID ON THE GROUNDS THAT KENNEDY WAS UNFAMILIAR WITH THE ACTING BUSINESS.

ALSO ON SALE WILL BE A "ROBOT" OR AUTOPEN-SIGNED LETTER FROM KENNEDY, THEN A SENATOR, OUTLINING HIS VIEWS ON NUCLEAR TESTING; AND A LETTER TO A DEMOCRATIC COMMITTEEWOMAN.

MRS. KENNEDY'S LETTERS INCLUDE AN EXCHANGE WITH ACTOR BASIL RATHBONE OVER AN IMPENDING PERFORMANCE AT THE WHITE HOUSE-- IN WHICH SHE PERSUADED THE ACTOR TO DO THE ST. CRISPIN SPEECH FROM SHAKESPEARE'S "HENRY V" BECAUSE IT WAS ONE OF THE PRESIDENT'S FAVORITES "FOR WHATEVER LOVELY DREAMS OF LEADING OR BEING LED ON TO VICTORY LURK IN HIS SOUL!"

ANOTHER, WRITTEN IN 1954, TURNS DOWN AN INVITATION BECAUSE OF KENNEDY'S ILLNESS AND THE FACT THAT "I HAVE TO FEED HIM ALL HIS MEALS OR HE WON'T EAT."

THE OSWALD OFFERINGS INCLUDE LETTERS TO HIS MOTHER, BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE, POSTCARDS AND OTHER MEMENTOES OF THE SLAIN ASSASSIN, OFFERED FOR SALE BY HIS MOTHER.

THE JUXTAPOSITION OF THE KENNEDY AND OSWALD LETTERS TAKES ON LESS SIGNIFICANCE WHEN A STUDY OF THE CATALOGUE FOR THE SEPT. 30 SALE SHOWS THAT THEY ARE ALSO IN THE COMPANY OF HERMANN GOERING, MAHATMA GANDHI, ADOLF EICHMANN, NIKITA KHRUSHCHEV, CHARLES DE GAULLE, AND SCORES OF OTHER LIVING AND DEAD CELEBRITIES--INCLUDING THE BEATLES.
