DALLAS, TEX. FEB. 2 (AP)-MRS. MARINA OSWALD FLEW TO WASHINGTON TODAY TO TESTIFY BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

SHE WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THREE UNIDENTIFIED MEN AND HER 2-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER, JUNE LEE.

THE COMMISSION HAD ANNOUNCED THAT MRS. OSWALD, WIDOW OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO WAS ACCUSED OF KILLING KENNEDY AND WAS HIMSELF SHOT FATALLY, WOULD APPEAR AT THE COMMISSION OFFICES IN WASHINGTON AT 10 A.M. EST MONDAY.

SHE IS APPEARING VOLUNTARILY, A COMMISSION SPOKESMAN SAID.

MRS. OSWALD FLEW TO WASHINGTON ON A BRANIFF AIRWAYS PLANE. SHE REFUSED TO TALK TO NEWSMEN AND REPORTERS WERE NOT ALLOWED ON THE PLANE BEFORE IT DEPARTED.

HER PLANE WAS DUE AT NATIONAL AIRPORT IN WASHINGTON AT 7:30 P.M., EST.
