DALLAS, FEB. 8 (AP)-MRS. MARINA OSWALD, LOOKING PALE AND TIRED AFTER A WEEK OF TESTIMONY BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION IN WASHINGTON, RETURNED HOME BY COMMERCIAL AIRLINER TONIGHT.

THE RUSSIAN-BORN WIDOW OF ACCUSED PRESIDENTIAL ASSASSIN LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS WHISKED THROUGH LOVE FIELD AIRPORT BY HER SECRET SERVICE ESCORT.

"I HOPE NOW TO RETURN TO A NORMAL LIFE," SHE TOLD NEWSMEN.

ASKED IF SHE WAS TIRED AND WANTED A REST, SHE REPLIED, "YES, I WANT TO REST ONE YEAR."

ABOUT HER FUTURE, MRS. OSWALD SAID SHE WOULD LIKE TO LEARN ENGLISH AND BECOME AN AMERICAN CITIZEN.

SHE SAID SHE DID NOT WANT A PRIVATE TUTOR, BUT WOULD LIKE TO ATTEND A SCHOOL. SHE SAID SHE DID NOT KNOW WHAT SCHOOL, BUT ADDED THAT SHE WOULD LIKE TO LIVE IN THE DALLAS-FT. WORTH AREA.

MRS. OSWALD SAID SHE EVENTUALLY WOULD LIKE A JOB. "OH YES, I THINK AS A PHARMACIST."

ASKED IF SHE HAD SEEN ANYONE OFFICIALLY IN WASHINGTON OTHER THAN THE WARREN COMMISSION, SHE NODDED YES, BUT MADE NO OTHER COMMENT.

SHE SAID SHE RECEIVED NO WORD FROM PRESIDENT JOHNSON DURING HER STAY IN THE NATION'S CAPITAL. SHE ALSO SAID SHE HAD NOT SEEN ANY MEMBER OF THE KENNEDY FAMILY, SAYING, "I DID NOT HAVE TIME."

MRS. OSWALD SAID SHE DID SOME SIGHTSEEING IN THE CAPITAL AND CLIMBED TO THE TOP OF THE WASHINGTON MONUMENT.

HER TWO-YEAR OLD DAUGHTER, JUNIE ACCOMPANIED MRS. OSWALD. THE OTHER SMALL DAUGHTER OF THE ASSASSIN'S WIDOW, RACHEAL, REMAINED HERE.
