HOUSTON, TEX., FEB. 26 (AP)-THE HOUSTON POST QUOTED AN ASSOCIATE OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD'S WIDOW TONIGHT AS SAYING OSWALD PLANNED TO KILL FORMER VICE PRESIDENT RICHARD M. NIXON.

THE POST QUOTED JAMES MARTIN, UNTIL A FEW DAYS AGO MRS. MARINA OSWALD'S BUSINESS REPRESENTATIVE, AS SAYING THAT EVIDENCE TO THIS EFFECT HAD BEEN PRESENTED TO THE WARREN COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

NIXON WAS IN DALLAS THE DAY BEFORE PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS KILLED. OSWALD WAS CHARGED WITH THE SLAYING.

THE POST SAID MARTIN WOULD NOT SAY HOW HE HAD LEARNED OF OSWALD'S ALLEGED INTENT TO ASSASSINATE NIXON.

IT'S PART OF THE TESTIMONY," SAID MARTIN, "I CAN'T COMMENT ON IT."

THE POST SAID MARTIN WOULD NOT COMMENT ON WHY HE SUDDENLY HAD BEEN DISMISSED BY MRS. OSWALD A FEW DAYS AGO. REPORTS AT THE TIME SAID HE HAD BEEN DISMISSED ON THE ADVICE OF ROBERT OSWALD, BROTHER OF THE ACCUSED ASSASSIN.

MARTIN IS SCHEDULED TO TESTIFY BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION TOMORROW IN WASHINGTON.
