Dallas July 24 (AP) - Marina Oswald, widow of accused presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, gave a deposition to a Warren commission investigator today.

She appeared at U.S. Atty: Barefoot Sanders' office with her two small daughters. The youngsters were carried by two Dallas-based Secret Service agents.

Mrs. Oswald gave the deposition to Wesley J. Liebeler, a commission lawyer.

It was the third time the Russian-born widow has given testimony to the commission. On two previous occasions she testified before the full commission in Washington.

Her lawyer, William McKenzie, accompanied Mrs. Oswald.

The blonde widow wore a pink summer dress and low-heeled shoes. Her daughters, June, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$, and Rachel, 9 months, also went into the room where their mother answered questions.
