THE RUSSIAN-BORN WIDOW OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ACCUSED ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, ATTENDED HER FINAL CLASSES IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE.

MRS. OSWALD, 23, AND HER CAMPUS ADVISERS DECLINED TO DISCLOSE HER TRAVEL PLANS.

A UNIVERSITY SOURCE SAID, HOWEVER, SHE WAS EXPECTED TO RETURN TO RICHARDSON, TEXAS, A SUBURB OF DALLAS AND REJOIN HER TWO CHILDREN.

A PRETTY, BLUE-EYED BLONDE, MRS. OSWALD FITTED INTO THE CAMPUS YOUNG PEOPLE'S PICTURE.

BUT HER TWO MONTHS HERE WERE QUIET. SHE GAVE ONLY ONE INTERVIEW-- ON HER FIRST DAY. THE UNIVERSITY TOOK STEPS NOT TO EMPHASIZE HER PRESENCE. A PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH GROUP TOOK CARE OF HER LIVING ACCOMMODATIONS.

SHE MADE OCCASIONAL TRIPS TO DETROIT AND ONCE ATTENDED A DETROIT PISTONS PROFESSIONAL BASKETBALL GAME AT COBO ARENA WITHOUT BEING RECOGNIZED, A UNIVERSITY SPOKESMAN SAID.

FRIENDS MADE BY MRS. OSWALD ON THE CAMPUS SAID SHE DECLARED SHE ENJOYED THE MICHIGAN WINTER BECAUSE IT REMINDED HER OF HER HOME IN RUSSIA.

MRS. OSWALD STUDIED AT THE UNIVERSITY'S ENGLISH LANGUAGE INSTITUTE IN COMPANY WITH 30 OTHER STUDENTS FROM FOREIGN COUNTRIES. THE INSTITUTE GIVES CERTIFICATES ON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE.

GEORGE LUTHER, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTE, DESCRIBED MRS. OSWALD AS AN AVERAGE STUDENT.

MRS. OSWALD CAME HERE FROM TEXAS IN EARLY JANUARY, LEAVING HER CHILDREN, MARINA RACHEL, 1, AND JUNE LEE, 3, IN THE CARE OF FRIENDS.
