Marina Has Him Arrested

'Drinking And a Gun'

DALLAS—(UPI)—Marina Oswald Porter, wife of presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, yesterday filed a complaint against her husband of 3½ months, charging he had threatened to kill himself.

She told a Dallas Justice of the Peace she was afraid her husband would kill her and her children.

Her husband, Kenneth Jess Porter, was taken into custody at his home in Richardson and held in the Dallas County Jail, the same jail which houses the murderer of his wife's first husband.

Justice of the Peace W. E. (Bill) Richburg said Marina called him and said her husband had been drinking and had a gun. Richburg said Marina was afraid Porter might shoot her and her two children.

Richburg suggested to Marina that she and her husband come into his court in an attempt to settle matters and then told her to put her husband on the phone.

"He (Porter) told me that he didn't care if Marina filed a complaint," said Richburg.

On the basis of the phone call, Richburg said he issued

a warrant for Porter's arrest. Two of Sheriff Bill Decker's deputies went to the Dallas suburb and took Porter into custody.

TWO CHILDREN

Porter was taken to the county jail, but his wife went to Richburg's court in the Oak Cliff section of Dallas.

With her when she arrived were her two children, June Lee, 3, and Rachael, 2, along with her babysitters identified only as a Mr. and Mrs. Smith.

Marina showed none of the smiles shown last June 1 when she and her husband were married.

She told newsmen to "leave me alone." Richburg said a hearing could be held on the complaint at any time but indicated it would not be held tonight.

Richburg recently was the victim of a heart attack, and his duties have been somewhat curtailed.

Marina, her children, and the Smiths hopped into a waiting car and sped away when coming out of court.

MARRIED JUNE 1

Marina and Porter were married June 1.

Her second marriage came a year and a half after her first husband, Lee Harvey Oswald, shot and killed President John F. Kennedy. Oswald was himself killed two days later, on Nov. 24, 1963, by Jack Ruby.

Porter was married twice before his marriage to Marina. They settled down in Marina's home in Richardson. He is an electronics technician at the Texas Instruments plant in Richardson.
