## Marina Off On Second Honeymoon

DALLAS—(UPI)—The former Marina Oswald slipped out of town yesterday for a second honeymoon with the bridegroom she put under a \$1,500 peace bond Wednesday for slapping her.

Marino, 24, the widow of presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, married Kenneth Porter, 27, an electronics company foreman, in May. Porter had to go to jail Wednesday night until he could raise the bond.

They were reunited Thursday in justice of the peace Bill Richburg's court. They announced that they had made up and would consult a marriage counselor.

Marina had complained about Porter's owning a pistol and Richburg ordered Porter to turn it over. Porter was supposed to deliver the gun yesterday to Charles Tessmer, his lawyer, so Tessmer could hand it over to Richburg.

They broke the appointment to leave town for a second honeymoon and Tessmer said he will get the gun from the babysitter Marina left with her children, June Lee, 3, and Rachael, 2. Oswald was their father.
