

Oswald Widow Has a Son 7-4-66

RICHARDSON, Tex. (AP) — Mrs. Marina Oswald Porter, widow of the man the Warren Commission said assassinated President John F. Kennedy, had a 6-pound, 12-ounce boy Sunday at Richardson General Hospital, the Dallas Morning News said. Richardson is a suburb of Dallas.

Mrs. Porter, widow of Lee Harvey Oswald, married Kenneth J. Porter on June 1, 1965, about 18 months after her husband was shot to death by nightclub operator Jack Ruby.

Mrs. Porter, 24, has two children by her first marriage, June, 5, and Rachel, 2.

Porter, 28, recently quit his job with a Dallas area electronics firm. He has said he and his wife may move to Greenville, 60 miles northeast of Dallas, where he has relatives.
