When June Oswald, now 8, was in the second grade, her class was studying President John F. Kennedy. June piped up during the study: "My first daddy killed him."

Marina Oswald Porter, June's mother, tells about her daughter's reaction to the Kennedy study in an interview in Redbook released yesterday.

"The first week Junie went to school, I talked to her about it," Mrs. Porter said. "I have to open my mouth because I am afraid if somebody tells her before me, she will be hurt more.

"Oh, it was the hardest thing. We cried a little. Then she asked some questions, and I answered, so that she won't have the wrong feelings."

Lee Harvey Oswald married Marina in Russia two years before he assassinated Kennedy in Dallas on Nov. 22, 1963. Marina and Kenneth Jess Porter, 32, were married in June, 1965.
